#### How big is your site and how many staff do you employ?

We have 1 site with 5 Principal Investigators, 6 Research Coordinators, 1 Recruiter, 1 Quality Assurance Coordinator and myself. We are embedded within a multispecialty practice that includes 56 medical providers covering Adult Medicine, Pediatrics, OBGYN, Occupational Medicine and same day walk in clinic

#### How many Summit studies do you run?

We try to only have 2-4 actively enrolling Summit studies at a time with another 3-4 studies ongoing but not enrolling.

### What brought you to Summit?

We were one of the first few sites that joined Summit. Dr. Harrison approached us and shared his concept with us about creating a network of NASH sites. We were immediately interested due to his knowledge and expertise in the NASH field. This is a very difficult disease. Dr. Harrison and the Summit team have taught us so much about NASH and NASH Research. Drs. Kosinski, Vander Veen and myself knew this was definitely an unmet medical need and felt we should all learn more about this disease for our patients. We have so many NASH patients and it is vastly

underdiagnosed in the primary care world. With the help of Summit, we are making progress in our group but still have a long way to go.

## What is the most valuable thing you get from Summit?

Their vast knowledge and expertise. The entire Summit team is top notch. We tell patients that by joining one of our NASH studies they are getting access to some of the world's leading experts. This is incredible for our patients to have access to this type of medical care in Clarksville, TN.
